The internships will be a combination of teaching responsibilities as well as administrative coordination. ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assists Camp Director with coordinating and preparing for all of the summer camps, including communication with Camp Director in advance of the camp week.
- Teaching opportunities throughout the week with the camp students in a group setting or in sectionals, including team-building activities and music lessons. The Camp Director and Director of Music Programs will work with the intern to develop their specific teaching responsibilities and lesson plans.
- Management of various administrative tasks throughout the week, including preparing supplies and instruments, concert programs, and other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Current undergraduate or graduate student in a music degree program
- Experience working with children and youth in a music setting.
- Knowledge and ability to develop a lesson plan for teaching responsibilities throughout the week.
- Must have a reliable form of transportation to travel to camp locations.
