### Position Summary:

Want to spend your summer in a creative, fun environment while helping out and learning new skills? The **Arts+ Counselor in Training (CIT)** will gain volunteer experience participating in summer camps, working with younger students, and getting a behind-the-scenes look at how arts programs run. CITs gain confidence, teamwork skills, and early leadership experience—all while being a part of a supportive, welcoming community.

Camps are Monday-Friday, 8:30am-4:30pm and run from mid-June through mid-August. Schedules vary based on availability, and Counselors in Training are not expected to work every week.

### What you'll do:

- Be an extra set of hands in camp spaces.
- Help with fun, simple tasks like assisting with transitions, organizing supplies, and setting up rooms.
- Support counselors and interns by helping keep classrooms calm, safe, and organized.
- Be a positive role model and help make Arts+ a fun place to learn and create.

- Students age 12-15.
- Friendly, responsible students who enjoy working with others.
- No arts or teaching experience needed, just a willingness to help and participate.
