



- Markers, crayons, or colored pencils




PART 1: Folding and drawing the face

Steps


- #1: Using your paper, create the folds which will hide your 'mouth'. The goal is to create a surface with the face showing and also a hidden pocket which will be the interior of the 'mouth'.



- #2: Decide what type of creature or character you want to draw and begin drawing your outline with pencil. Make sure you line up the mouth with the fold in the paper. For an extra challenge, you can also have other parts of the drawing 'open up' such as the head.




- #3: Finish your surface drawing and trace the lines with a sharpie. Erase any pencil lines. Color in your drawing with colored pencils or another material of your choosing.




PART 2: Drawing the interior and the reveal!

Steps

- #1: Now open up your paper to its full length and using the drawing you have already created, line up the edges and draw the interior of the mouth (or head, etc.). Outline this with a sharpie and erase any stray pencil marks.



- #2: Decide what objects, characters, or other images should be 'inside' of that mouth and draw those in pencil, then trace with sharpie. Color in the mouth area and anything inside of it.



- #3: Fold your drawing back up so that only the exterior of the fold shows and the pocket or 'mouth' is hidden again. Using one hand on the top of the paper and one hand on the bottom, gently pull to open up the fold and reveal the hidden surprise in your drawing!
